Mystery and Hamadryad launches their new album with a double show at the Olympia of Montreal, Saturday May 22nd, 2010.

Montreal on February 22th, 2010 - The Montreal band Mystery with Benoît David, who sings presently with the group Yes, and Hamadryad, will launch their last album during a double program which will be presented at l'Olympia de Montréal, Saturday May 22nd 2010.

For Mystery, *One Among the Living* is their fifth album while Hamadryad will launch its fourth album entitled *Intrusion*. These two Montreal bands are on the Quebec rock scene for more than 10 years and developed their own sound.

The music of Mystery evolved over the last 20 years as ages a good wine. The reorganizations inside the band added successively the pieces which makes of Mystery one of the most respected groups. Sensible mixture of Art rock and classic rock, Hamadryad adds a touch of cinematic vision which transports the listener in an exceptional musical adventure.

This event will also mark the return of Mystery from ROS fest in the United States and Hamadryad will prepare its French tour planned in August 2010 while they will be the headliner of the Festival Crescendo. Both groups also plan to make the promotion of their new album and to present shows everywhere in Quebec in 2010.

The members of Mystery and Hamadrayd will welcome people who will attend the shows during the launch of both albums which will precede the evening and which is planned at 5:30 pm.

Tickets will be on sale at the box office of l'Olympia and the Admission network on Saturday, February 27th, 2010 at the price of 39\$ to 49\$.
